

All abilities beach access. This was raised at the 2023 AGM and a site visit by David King on 10 February, 2023 committed to levelling the sandy track and look at some sort of matting to be laid to make access easier. This was considered the best option. Due to unexpected events nothing was achieved.

7. Other Business:

Katie mentioned the constant watering of the service track between 4th & 5th Avenue by Some leaseholders. Also, dogs being allowed to roam on their own, running up to people and being without a lead.

Reg followed up the sprinkler erected on the Service track and the Shire is aware of it now. The signs for Rame Head and The Gap have been sourced and will be erected.

Hayden - A community member was concerned about speeding on the beach (this was overlooked at the AGM). The Progress will write and request a 40k speed limit sign to be erected on the approach to the vehicle access to the boat ramp/inlet beach.

Jude asked if we had an asset register and requested clarification on our funding status. Hayden will follow this up as it will be required as part of the Shire taking over the maintenance in the Bay which will then be finalised.

Mavis will raise a work order to have the steps near Sea Rescue building cleared of sand.

(Katie indicated the Sea Rescue will take care of the sand buildup in front of the no parking signs near the jetty.)
