PRESIDENTS REPORT

Hello everyone,

I can't believe it's that time of year again. Summer is trying to happen as I'm writing this. Rainfall has been very sparse this year with the puddles on the tracks not appearing or only just existing. With that in mind please remember that our water supply is also a finite resource. At the moment the Denmark Shire would like us to adhere to the same watering days as you do at home. Water Corporation website lets you know the days. Please, there is no need to water 24/7!. The Denmark Shire have committed to expanding the solar panels on the bore feeding the lagoon and installing a battery so that more water is delivered. It is expected that this will happen before the Holiday season begins. Also the Denmark Shire did re-sheet the gravel roads around the Village. A long time coming but hopefully a vast improvement on previous efforts. Dust suppressant has been applied but do remember that the best way to stop the dust is to drive SLOW!. The PBPA purchased and installed 3 bench seats - one on the ring road path, one at the beginning of the Sandy Track and one behind the RSL Memorial overlooking the water. Many thanks to Jeremy for assisting with this. The Sandy track to the swimming beach has had some work done to reduce the severity of the climb off the beach. This may go further as the Shire want to gauge public opinion before more work is done. Hopefully this will go a long way to make access to and from the beach a lot easier for all.

Flag Hill will now live up to its' name with the installation of a pole and WA Flag. Thanks to Tony and Jeremy for that one.

I would like to thank the committee members of the PBPA for the great job they do for Peaceful Bay. It does provide our community with a great conduit in dealings with Government authorities on a local and state level and we continue to work in the background doing stuff

<u>Peaceful Bay Sea Rescue</u> - (Marine Rescue Peaceful Bay) - The committee urge boaters to Log on and Log off using Repeater Channel 22 as there are black spots on Channel 16. The reason for this is your SAFETY and to make our job easier and safer to locate you in an emergency.

<u>RSL – Sub Branch – Peaceful Bay</u> – The RSL will be holding an *Australia Day Family BBQ* at the Progress Hall on First Avenue, Sunday 26th January, starting from 12.00 Midday. ALL WELCOME.

<u>Peaceful Bay Stitch & Bitch Craft Group</u> – Meets in the Community Hall on First Avenue every Monday at 9.30. Come along and join in, you will be welcomed.

4WD Around Peaceful Bay - Please consider the environment when using your 4WD vehicle at the Bay. Reducing tyre pressure is a sound practice to make your experience hassle free - 16 PSI is a good tyre pressure to start with as it takes the pressure off the tracks AND your vehicle. Also, please take your rubbish back with you. Don't leave it in the bush or on the beach!

<u>Dogs</u> - Dogs must always be on a leash in the village. Owners should also make sure their dogs are not allowed to roam the village on their own as they can be a nuisance around other people's cottages. Although the Inlet beach does allow dogs off leash it is required that dogs be under your strict control for their safety and the enjoyment of other beach users.

<u>Bushfire Ready Plan</u> – We remind the community to revisit their bushfire emergency plan and advise that DFES has an App to help you prepare a Bushfire Ready Plan. The Shire of Denmark has an SMS function that will alert you to various events including bushfires. Visit the Shire's Website and select the alerts you want to receive. The Peaceful Bay Progress Association Website has a link to click on to access this service. Given that Peaceful Bay has one road in and one road out, the best and safest option in an emergency would be to leave early. The Denmark Shire has a **BAN** on all open fires. This means cooking fires and drum/fire pits as well. This applies across the whole SHIRE not just us.

<u>Tree Loppings' Dump</u> – The loppings dump is not attracting as much unwanted rubbish and the area is still being monitored. Thank you to those volunteers involved in maintaining this facility, your efforts are appreciated by the Peaceful Bay community.
